Participant levels:

1. Undergraduates
2. Post-Graduates
3. Research Scholars – PhD
4. Open – Below 40 years of age.

Entry Requirements

- **Authorship:** Papers written by more than one author will not be permitted.
- **Single Submission:** Only one paper per author allowed.
- **Originality:** Paper must be an original analysis and work of author. Previously published papers are not eligible. (Similarity index of less than 10%)
- **Registration:** Registration and submission of Research Paper on BSM's official website www.bsmbharat.org.
- **Registration Contribution:** ₹100/-
- **Last date of Registration:** August 30, 2022
- **Last date for Research Paper submission:** September 25, 2022 (by midnight IST)

Paper Preparation Requirements

Language

- The paper can be written in any Bharatiya Language or in English.

Length

- Word limit of Paper should be 3000 to 6000.

Appearance and Format

- English Font: 'Arial' or 'Calibri'; for Bharatiya languages: 'Unicode'. Font size: 10-12.
- Margins should be of 1 inch (2.5 cm) all around.
- Paper must be submitted in Word and PDF format.

Charts and Citations

- Charts and graphs should be 'stylized', i.e., exhibits should be developed, formatted, and inserted into the document appropriately. Cutting and pasting direct output from statistical software into the document is not acceptable.
- Datasets, publications, and other documentation must be properly cited.
- Sources or references should be cited systematically and accurately.

Title Page and Abstract

- The title page must include the author's name, institutional affiliation, Date of Birth, Contact number and email address.
- Page headers and/ or footers should contain page numbers and a shortened title of the paper. They are not to include the author's name or the name of his or her institution. This ensures anonymous review by the judges.

Registration

1. For registration, please visit the official website of Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal www.bsmbharat.org. After Payment, attach the screenshot of your payment receipt.

Judging

- **Panels:** Papers will be judged by panels of at least three judges from among BSM officials and member institutions.
- **Criteria:** Papers will be judged according to scholarly criteria. Originality, analysis and solution-oriented approach will be given priority.
- **Anonymity:** The judges will not know the entrants' name or institution.

Awards

- Announcement: October 21, 2022 (state level).
- All copyrights of paper publication will be with Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal.
- Winner will receive a certificate in recognition of the award.
